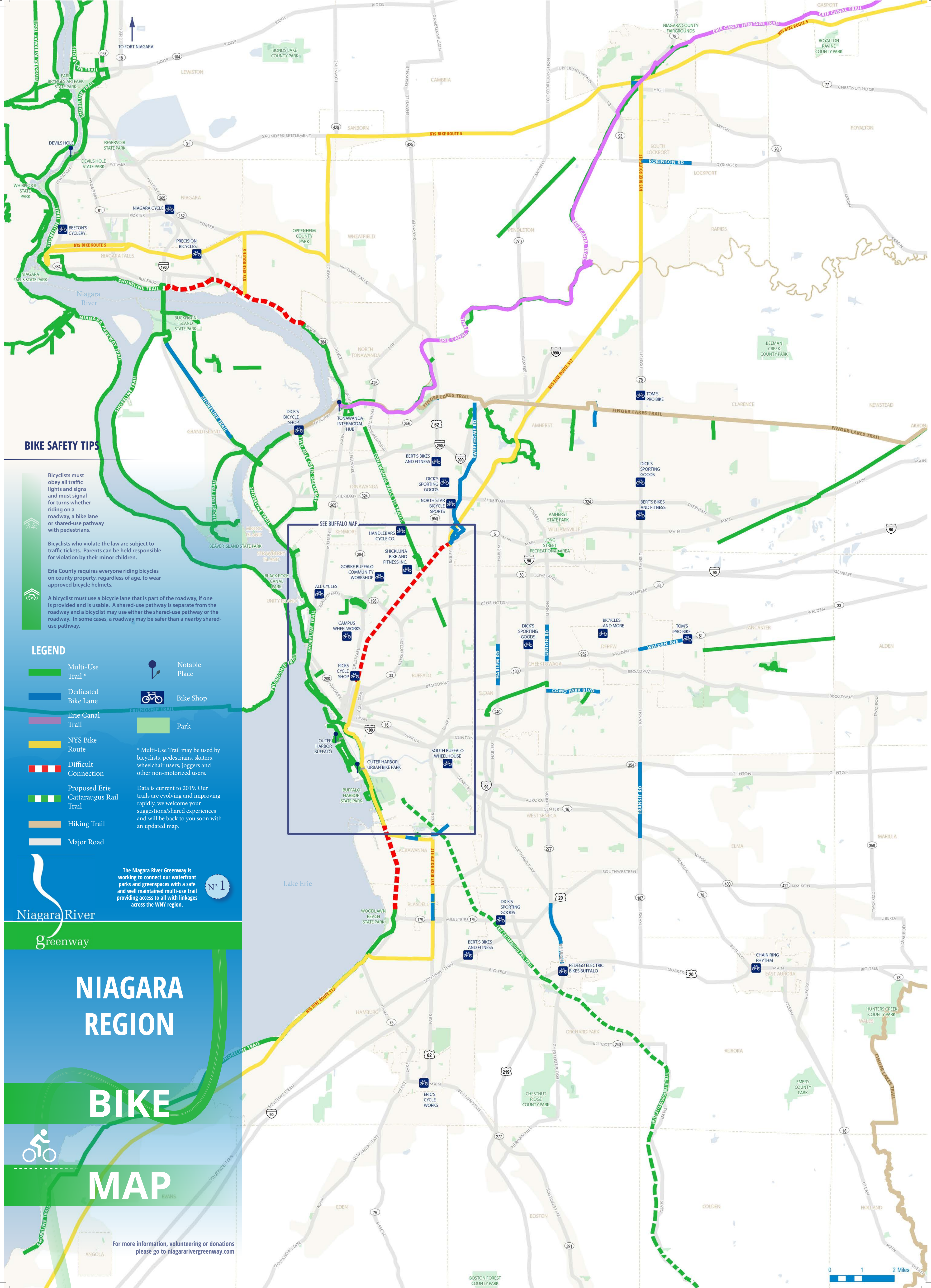

BIKE SAFETY TIPS

- Bicyclists must obey all traffic lights and signs and must signal for turns whether riding on a roadway, a bike lane or shared-use pathway with pedestrians.
- Bicyclists who violate the law are subject to traffic tickets. Parents can be held responsible for violation by their minor children.
- Erie County requires everyone riding bicycles on county property, regardless of age, to wear approved bicycle helmets.
- A bicyclist must use a bicycle lane that is part of the roadway, if one is provided and is usable. A shared-use pathway is separate from the roadway and a bicyclist may use either the shared-use pathway or the roadway. In some cases, a roadway may be safer than a nearby shared-use pathway.
